SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

We use the present simple to talk about: daily routines, hobbies, habits and general truths.

- The present tense is the **base form** of the verb:
*I **play** football every weekend. I **work** in New York.*
- With **she/he/it**, we add **-s, -es or ies**:
*He **plays** football every day. She **works** in New York.*

Positive Form (+)		
I You We They	get up	early every day.
He She It	get s up	

Negative Form (-)	
I You We They	don't get up late.
He She It	doesn't get up late.

Question Form (?)		
Do	I you we they	get up early?
Does	he she it	

Short Answers

Yes, I/you/we/they **do**.
No, I/you/we/they **don't**.

Yes, he/she/it **does**.
No, he/she/it **doesn't**.

Third Person Singular

- Verbs ending in -y** : the third person changes the **-y** to **-ies**:
fly --> flies cry --> cries
Exception: if there is a vowel before the -y:
play --> plays pay --> pays
- Add **-es** to verbs ending in: **-ss, -x, -sh, -ch, -o**:
he passes she catches he fixes it pushes she does

Note: have --> has

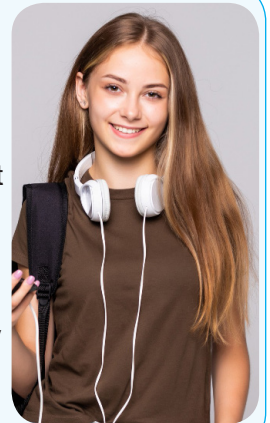
