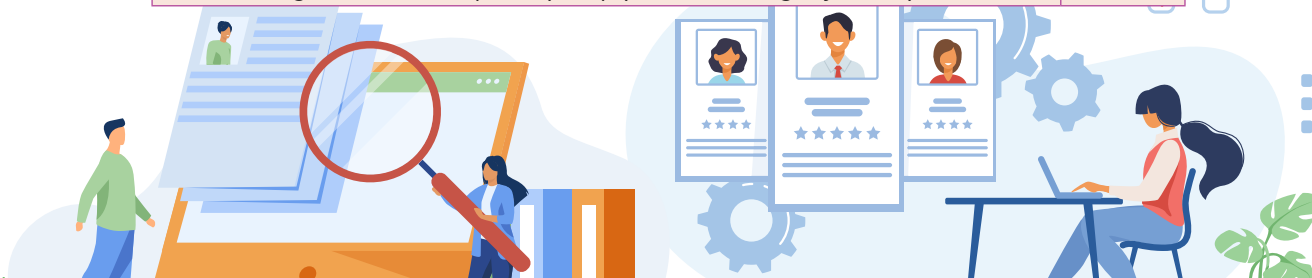
Second, you should think about the problems in your previous job and make changes in them before you take the new job. You should also ask for changes in your new working conditions if you think some of them may create problems for you.
