Another interesting festival is from Mexico: Día de los Muertos. It is translated into English as "the day of the dead". This festival is celebrated to remember the people who died. People paint skulls on their faces. Costumes are worn, paper decorations are put up, and parades are held. The spirits of the dead are honoured through music and dances. The festival is held in late October to early November.
