In the old district, which is full of historical houses, you can find cafés where young people meet after school.

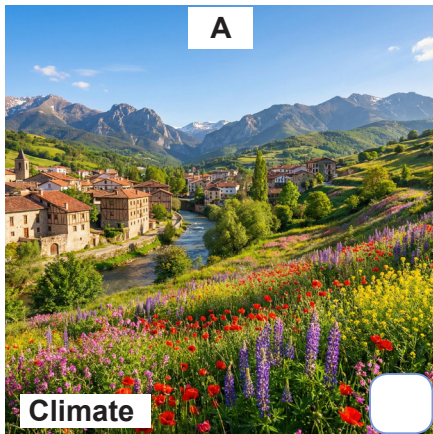
