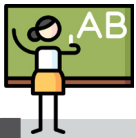

A. "To be" (Present)

Form (affirmative):

- I am (I'm) Turkish. • You are (you're) Spanish. • He/She/It is (he's/she's/it's) Japanese.
- We/They are (we're/they're) German.

Negative: • I'm not Spanish. • He/She isn't German. • We/They aren't Italian.

Questions & short answers:

Where are you from? — I'm from Türkiye.

What is your nationality? — I'm Turkish.

What is your native/official language? — It is Turkish. / My native language is Turkish.

B. Model "can" (Ability)

Form (affirmative): I/You/We/They/He/She can + base verb

Negative: I can't speak Chinese. • Tourists can't go for a hike in the desert (in İstanbul).

Language ability:

What languages can you speak? — I can speak Turkish and English.

Can she speak Japanese? — Yes, she can. / No, she can't.
