## Grammar Focus

**Present Progressive Tense**

We use the Present Progressive Tense to talk about:

- actions happening at the moment of speaking

**+ Positive Subject + am / is / are + verb (-ing)**

- I am cleaning the kitchen now. ■ She is making the bed in the bedroom.
- He is having a shower in the bathroom. ■ We are watching TV in the sitting room.

**- Negative Subject + am not / isn't / aren't + verb (-ing)**

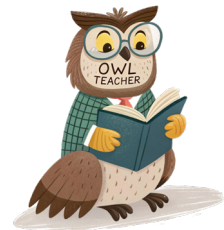
- I am not relaxing at the moment. ■ She isn't washing the dishes now.
- He isn't playing computer games in his bedroom. ■ They aren't having breakfast in the kitchen.

**? Yes / No Questions Am / Is / Are + subject + verb (-ing) ... ?**

- Are you washing the dishes now? ■ Is she brushing her teeth?
- Is he ironing clothes at the moment? ■ Are they cleaning the room?

**? Wh- Questions Wh-word + am / is / are + subject + verb (-ing) ... ?**

- What are you doing now? ■ Where is she having breakfast?
- What is he cleaning in the house? ■ Who is doing the laundry at the moment?

## Present Progressive Tense

- Actions happening now

## Subject + am / is / are + Ving

- My mother is cooking dinner now.
- She is tidying her room at the moment.
- I am doing my homework right now.
- My parents are watching TV now.

## Time Expressions

- now ■ at the moment ■ right now

## Simple Present Tense

- Daily routines, habits

## Subject + verb (he/she/it + verb-s)

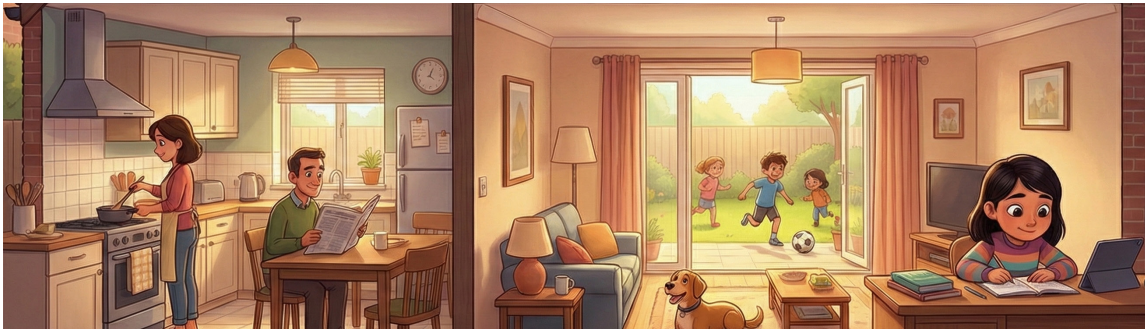
- My mother cooks dinner every evening.
- She tidies her room on Saturdays.
- I do my homework after dinner every day.
- My parents usually watch TV in the evenings.

## Time Expressions

- always ■ usually ■ every day
- on Sundays ■ in the evenings
