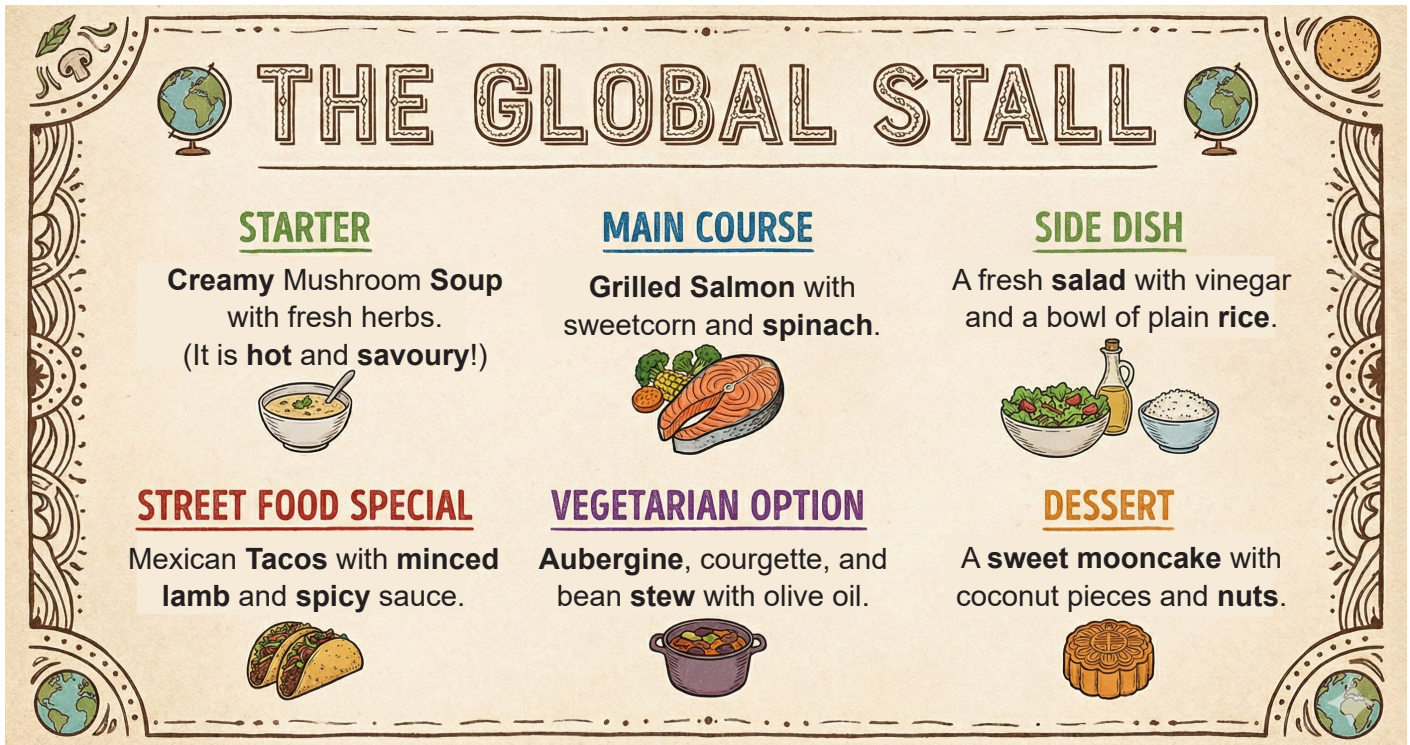

Present Progressive Tense

- Actions happening now

Subject + am / is / are + Ving

- The chefs are cooking an omelette now.
- We are tasting spicy tacos at the festival.
- The vendor is grilling kebabs at the moment.
- I am eating a creamy mushroom soup now.

Time Expressions

- now ■ at the moment ■ right now

Simple Present Tense

- Daily routines, habits

Subject + verb (he/she/it + verb-s)

- People eat street food at food festivals.
- Chefs cook omelette every year at this festival.
- Street vendors sell tacos and falafel.
- This cuisine uses fresh ingredients.

Time Expressions

- always ■ usually ■ every day
- on Sundays ■ in the evenings
