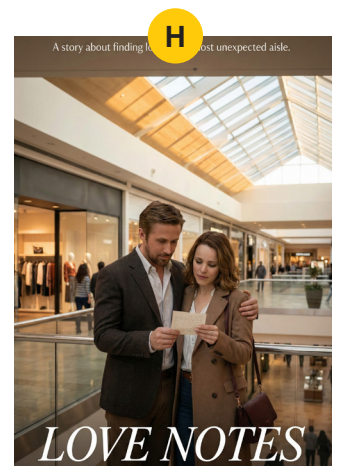
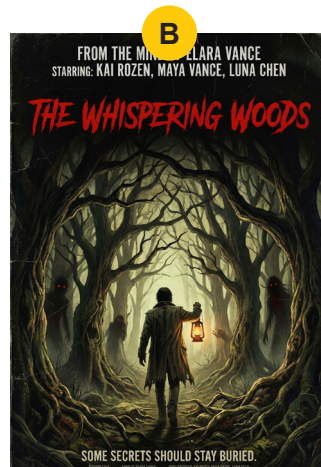

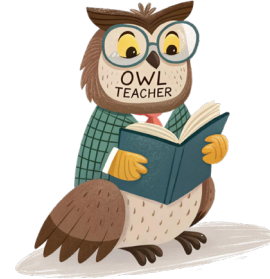

The Simple Future Tense – “will / won’t”

We use the Simple Future Tense with “will” to talk about predictions, opinions, guesses, expectations, advice, and recommendations.

+ Positive will + base verb

- Robots will help people in futuristic films.
- Scientists will invent new machines to explore space.
- People will travel to other planets in science fiction movies.
- Humans will live in virtual reality worlds in the future.

**– Negative will not (won’t) + base verb**

- Robots won’t replace humans completely.
- Humans won’t survive without technology.

? Wh- Questions Wh- word + will + subject + base verb ... ?
